

Navigating Big Interview

On the Career Center's Big Interview page, scroll to *Big Interview for Students*. Use your *NetID* and *Blue Password* to log in.




On first login, Big Interview will ask for demographic information. One question will ask you to select a *Profession* from a pull-down menu.


Student - Medical School is an option near the bottom of the list.

Once at the Dashboard, click on *Practice* in the top menu.

In the drop-down menu select *Practice Interviews*



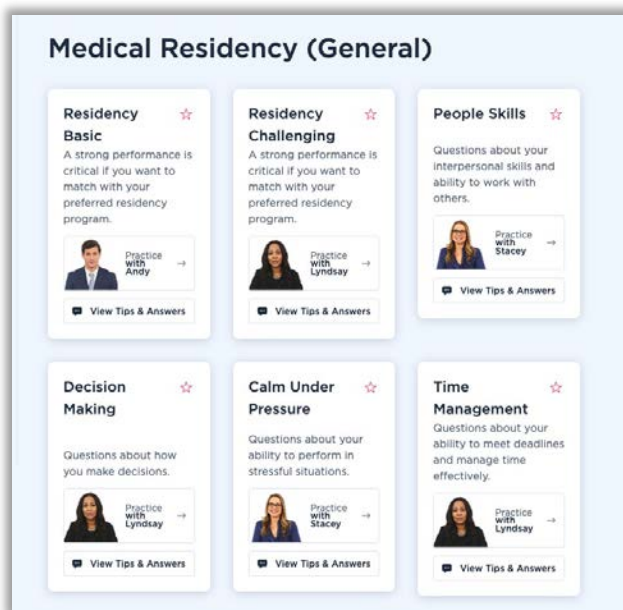
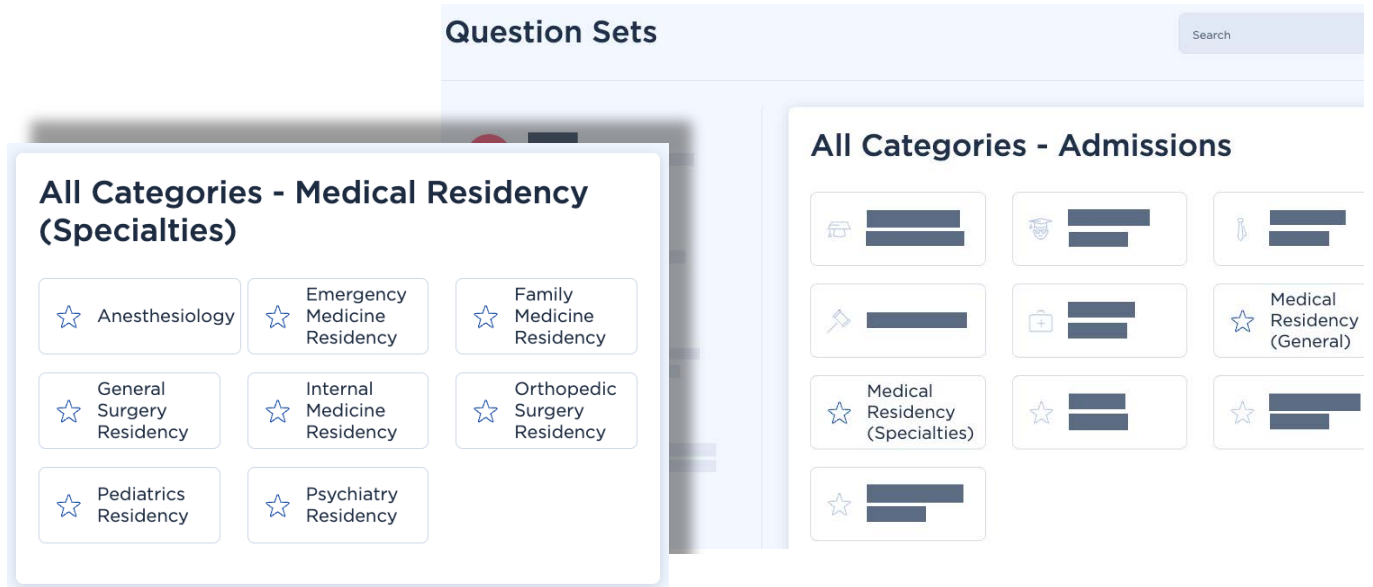
On the next page, select *Admissions* mock interviews



Question Sets for Medical Students

The Question Sets page options are:

1. **Medical Residency (General)** mock interview using a common set of residency interview questions
2. **Medical Residency (Specialties)** mock interview with questions related to specific area of practice



Once you select the question set, choose a group of mock interview questions. Questions are organized into skills and difficulty level. Select the question group you would like to practice.

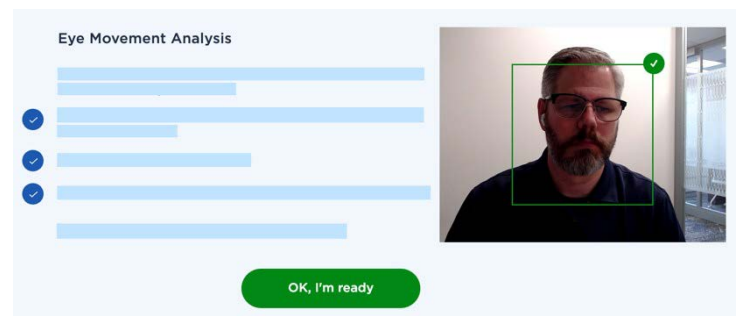
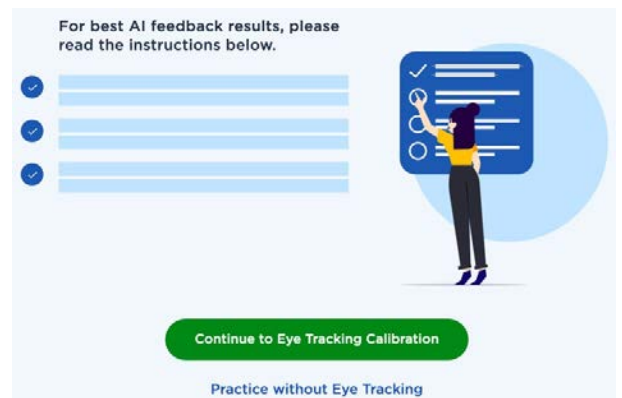
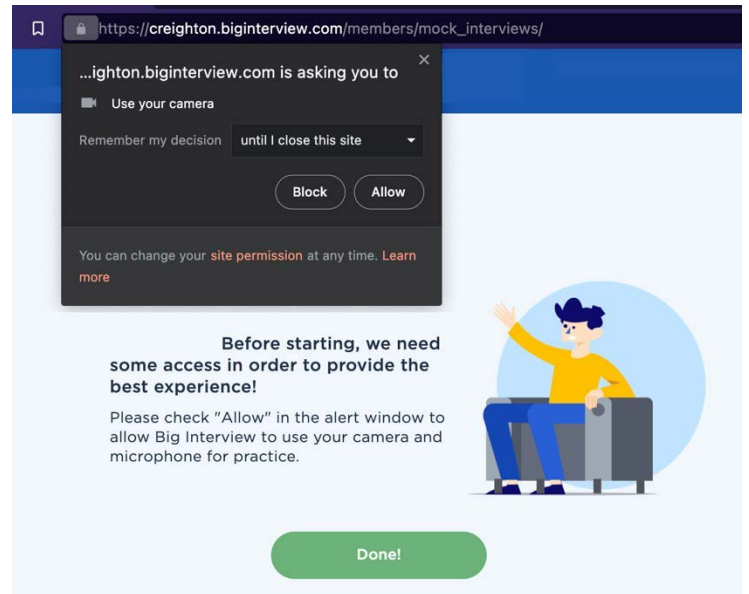
Configuring Your Computer

Since Big Interview uses your computer's camera and microphone to record your audio *and* video, you will be asked to allow Big Interview to access these two devices on your computer.

For Big Interview to function properly, you need to grant access to your camera *and* microphone.

Optionally, you can configure Big Interview's AI to conduct eye tracking. Click on the *Continue Eye Tracking Calibration* to use eye tracking.

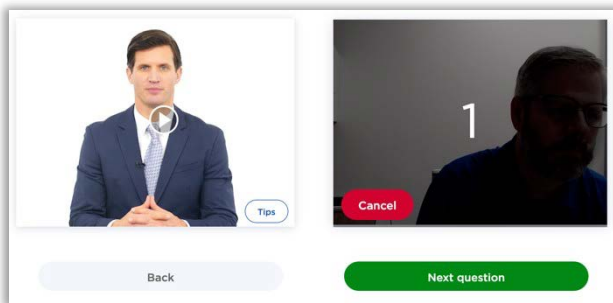
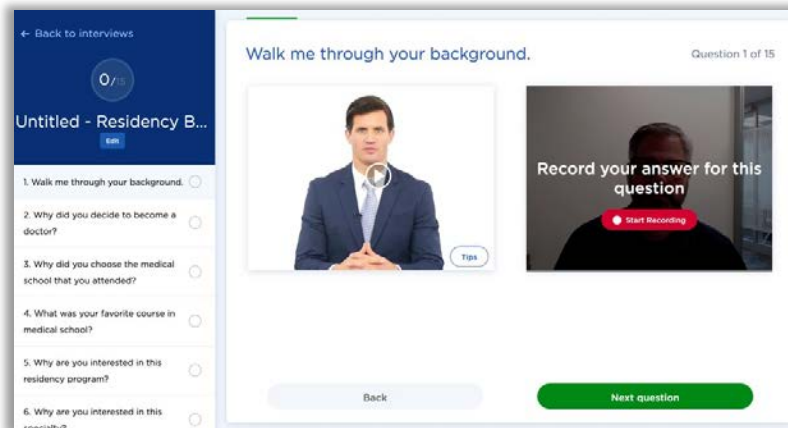
You will be asked to look at four red dots in the corners for the web browser to configure the application.



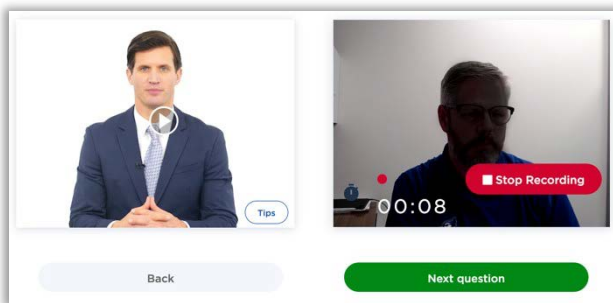
When you complete the configuration process you are ready to record. If the configuration doesn't work, you can still move forward to record your interview answers and review them.

Recording Your Answers

The mock interview questions are given as video recordings of the interviewer. Click on Start Recording button over your face to record your answer.

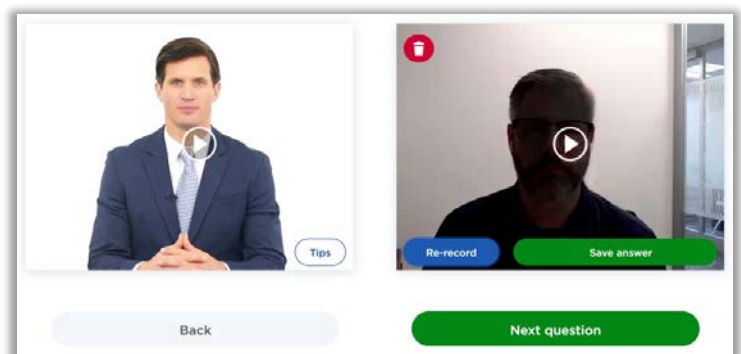


A 3 second countdown will begin on the screen.



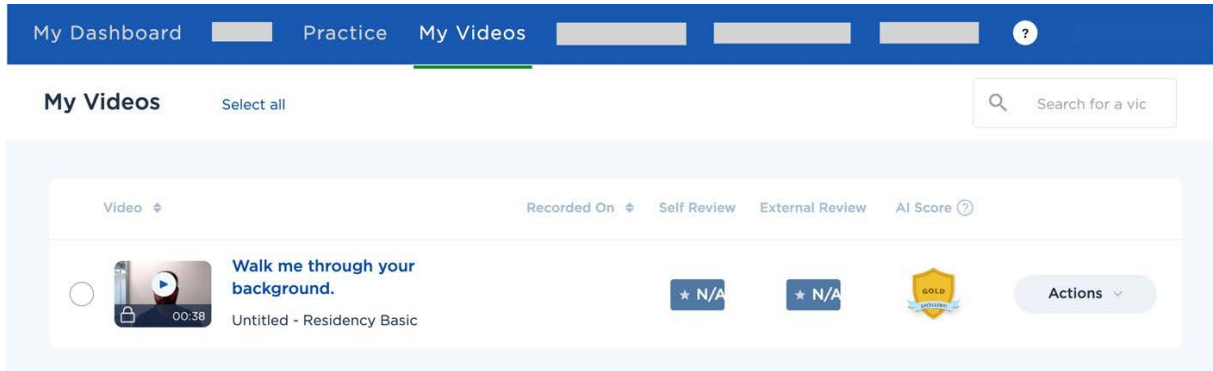
When you are done answering, click *Stop Recording*.

After recording, you can *Save Answer* or *Re-record* your answer. Once saved, click *Next Question*.

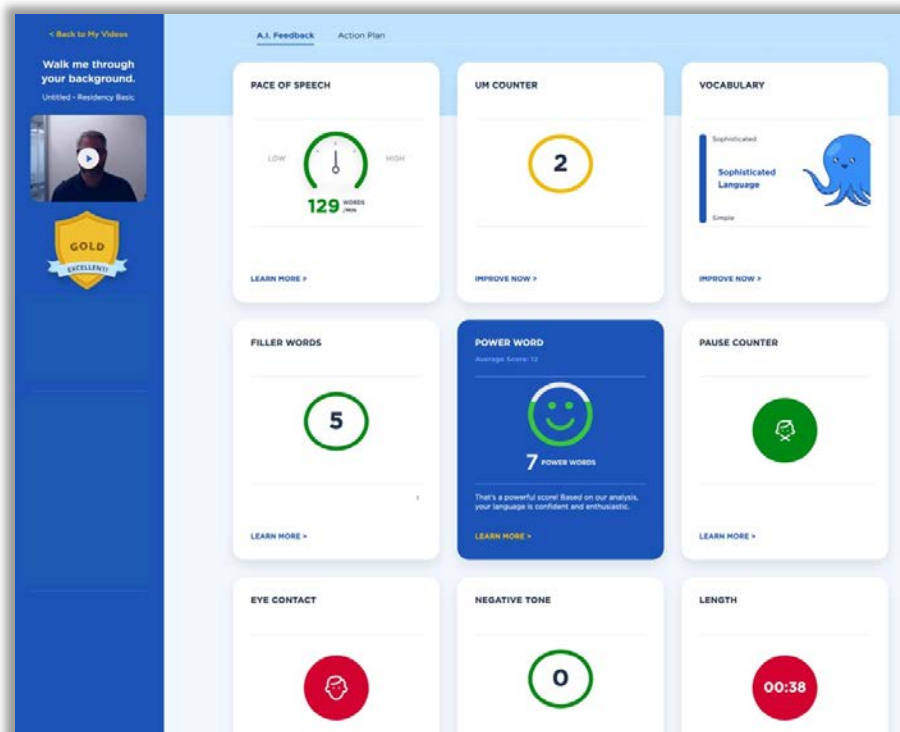
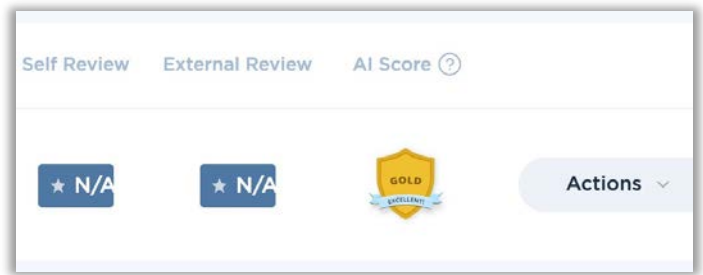


Reviewing Recordings

All your recorded videos will appear under the My Videos menu item.



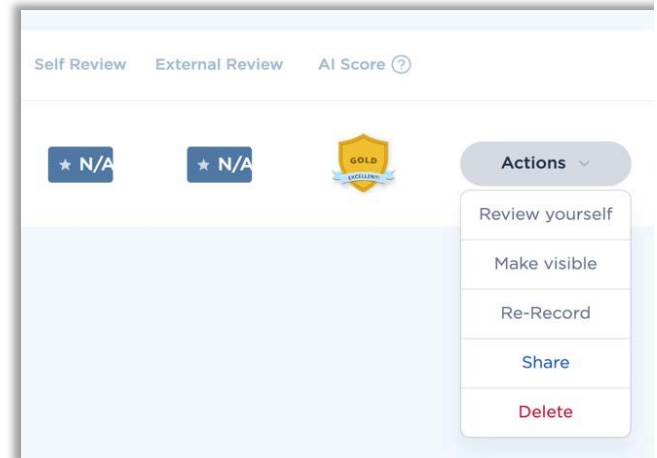
You can click on the shield under the AI Score to view AI feedback on your video.



A.I. offers basic feedback scores for Vocabulary, Pace of Speech, Lighting in the Room, etc.

Additional Options

Some additional options under the action menu include re-recording an answer or delete a video all together. Additionally, you can do a self-review of your recorded answers.



You can also share a recording. This allows someone to give additional feedback. The person does not need a Big Interview account to view the video or give feedback.
