Tips & Netiquette for ZOOM Webinars, DNP & Poster Presentations

- Use the most reliable source of internet available:

 - o If home wi-fi is unstable, consider using a mobile data hotspot (if more reliable)
- Dress for the webinar in the way you would for an in-person conference
- Join early AT LEAST 5 minutes before the start of the conference
- If you haven't used Zoom before, click the link to download Zoom prior to the day of the meeting and familiarize yourself with any features you may need to use on the day mute/unmute, microphone, stop/start video (speakers only), screenshare (speakers only), etc.
- Find a quiet space free from interruptions / background noise
- Be aware that during some sessions you may be on camera It is best to use built in breaks for snacks and other personal needs
