Tips & Netiquette for ZOOM Webinars, DNP & Poster Presentations

- Use the most reliable source of internet available:
 - If possible, connect directly to your internet modem and ask others in your household to avoid internet use (especially if you are scheduled to present)
 - If unable to directly connect, position yourself as close to your wi-fi router as reasonably possible
 - If home wi-fi is unstable, consider using a mobile data hotspot (if more reliable)
- Dress for the webinar in the way you would for an in-person conference
- Join early – AT LEAST 5 minutes before the start of the conference
- If you haven't used Zoom before, click the link to download Zoom prior to the day of the meeting and familiarize yourself with any features you may need to use on the day – mute/unmute, microphone, stop/start video (speakers only), screenshare (speakers only), etc.
- Find a quiet space free from interruptions / background noise
- Be aware that during some sessions you may be on camera - It is best to use built in breaks for snacks and other personal needs
- Microphones will be disabled for the main webinar session (except for speakers) - a chat box will be available for Q&A

'Virtual' Presenters Only

- Have a plain background – avoid backlight from bright windows
- Ensure that there will be no children or pets walking within view while you present
- Have good lighting on your face so you can be seen clearly
- Adjust your camera to be at around eye level if possible – especially take note of the angle of your laptop screen if using the built-in camera
- Practice speaking to the camera and not the screen and do not be afraid to project your voice
- Turn on your camera and unmute yourself before you begin presenting, and turn off your camera and mute when you are finished

Morning and Afternoon DNP / Poster Presentation Sessions for Viewers

- Keep cameras off during presentations to limit distractions for speakers
- Mute your microphone when not talking
- When asking questions during Q&A portion of break-out sessions, turn on your camera as a cue that you would like to ask a question. When asking, unmute your microphone and say your name first (pressing and holding the space bar while talking will temporarily 'unmute')
