PURPOSE

The Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) requires that Creighton University School of Medicine-Phoenix (CUSOM-PHX), as the Sponsoring Institution of record, to have a written policy that addresses harassment and discrimination. This policy is designed to ensure appropriate institutional oversight as mandated by the ACGME Institutional Requirements. This policy applies to all ACGME and non-ACGME Creighton CUSOM-PHX GME programs.

CUSOM-PHX is committed to promoting the health and welfare of House Staff Physicians (HSPs) by creating a supportive educational culture so that HSPs and fellows can work in an environment free of harassment and discrimination.

SCOPE

The policy applies to all CUSOM-PHX House Staff Physicians and their respective training programs, that are ACGME accredited or meet the criteria in the Non-ACGME Accredited Program Policy.

POLICY

Creighton University believes that each individual should be treated with respect and dignity, and that any form of harassment, discrimination, sexual and/or relationship misconduct is a violation of human dignity. In support of those beliefs, Creighton has the following policies:

Title IX Sexual Harassment policy, 2.1.35

Mandatory Reporters, 2.1.36

PROCEDURE

Any HSP who believes they may have a complaint based on discrimination or harassment may report that matter to the Office of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance. For more information, <https://www.creighton.edu/generalcounsel/title-ix-compliance>

Any GME faculty or staff who have reason to believe a violation of Policy 2.1.25 or 2.1.35 has occurred shall report the possible violation to the Office of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance. Any GME program

directors or GME office staff who receive a complaint from any member of the Creighton community that may fall under Policy 2.1.25 and/or 2.1.35 shall report that matter to the Office of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance. The Office of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance will have sole discretion to determine whether it will handle the complaint per its policies or refer the matter back to Creighton GME for resolution.
