



### Open Postdoctoral Position

We have an open postdoctoral [position](#) in the Department of Biomedical Sciences at the School of Medicine at Creighton University. We are strengthening existing research directions in the [Translational Hearing Center](#) via a 2-year position funded by the Bellucci Depaoli Family Foundation in BMS laboratories utilizing translational approaches to auditory and vestibular disorders (BMS faculty are listed [here](#)). These include development of othotherapeutics, genomic predisposition to, or non-genomic etiologies of, hearing loss and in research audiology and vestibular sciences. State-of-the art research core facilities with equipment for auditory and vestibular research, competitive salary and internal postdoctoral research funding opportunities are available.

Applicants should have a Ph.D., M.D., or M.D./Ph.D. degree with significant research accomplishments and scholarly promise. Application materials, including a CV, a brief summary of research to date and preferred research directions for the next few years, along with the names of **three** referees who can write letters of recommendation (at least one outside the applicant's home institution). **Applicants also should identify a Center PI** (see [website](#)) willing to mentor their post-doctoral training. Applications for Academic Year 2022-23 are accepted until the position is filled.
