Action Fund

The Creighton Student Sustainability Action Fund (CSSAF) supports **student-led, student-driven** projects that build a culture of sustainability on campus.

Projects should address **Environmental, Social** and **Economic** sustainability issues and engage the Creighton community.

Funding Categories

PROGRAMMATIC PROJECTS

These are **activity-based initiatives** that focus on education, engagement, or behavior change.

EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

- Hosting a sustainability-themed event or workshop
- Running a waste-reduction competition

RECEIVE FUNDING UP TO \$2,000

INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

These projects involve **physical improvements or installations** that create long-term sustainability benefits on campus.

EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

- Setting up composting or recycling systems
- Creating a pollinator garden or green space

RECEIVE FUNDING UP TO \$10,000

Application Process

GETTING STARTED

Prepare Your Project Idea

- Identify a sustainability issue you want to address
- Consider how your project will:
 - **Improve sustainability** at Creighton
 - **Involve and impact** students
 - **Tackle interconnected environmental, social and economic issues**

SUBMITTING YOUR PROPOSAL

Complete the Online Application

For the application you will need to provide:

- Project Leader Information
- Project Details
- Tasks and Milestones Timeline
- Download and fill out the **CSSAF Budget Template**
- Advisor Information
 - Upload the required **Letter of Support** using the CSSAF template

Submit your application at least one week before the next CSSAF meeting

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

After Submitting

- A CSSAF Coordinator will contact you with next steps
- **Infrastructure Projects** may require additional details before review

Reimbursement

- Funds are distributed **after** approved purchases are made
 - Funds will be issued to the designated project leader

- **Keep all original receipts** for items or services purchased
 - Submit receipts to the CSSAF coordinator

- **Important:** Only items listed in your approved budget will be reimbursed
