Common First Semester Courses: Required in First Semester Take PHL 11X or THL 11X Take Critical Issues/COM 101 or MTH 161 Other Common Options

- ¹ All Heider students are strongly encouraged to complete a Philosophical Ethics course (PHL 270, PHL 271, or PHL 272) because any of these courses fulfill both the Magis Common Core: Ethics requirement and the prerequisite for BUS 356 Business Ethics. Courses in Theological Ethics (i.e., THL 27X) do not fulfill the prerequisite for BUS 356.
- ² For the Global & Cross-Cultural Business requirement, select among [ACC 538](#) International Accounting, [ECO 518](#) Comparative Economic Systems, [ECO 528](#) International Economic Development, [ECO 538](#) International Economics, [FIN 558](#) International Financial Management, [MKT 363](#) Global Marketing, or [MGT 373](#) International Management. If applicable, students may apply their Global & Cross-Cultural Business course to their Heider Major. No other courses from the Heider Business Core – Upper Division or Heider Business Core – Lower Division may be applied toward a Heider Major.
- ³ A candidate for the degree of Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) Pre-Health Sciences must complete all of the following graduation requirements:
 - Complete all Magis Common Core requirements
 - Complete Heider Business Core, including General, Lower Division, and Upper Division
 - Complete requirements for a Heider Major, achieving a GPA of 2.00 or above for all required courses in a major
 - Complete [BUS 471](#) Strategic Management with a grade of “C” or better (i.e., “C-” or lower is insufficient)
 - Earn a minimum of 128 credit hours, including:
 - 48 credit hours in courses numbered 300 or above
 - 48 credit hours earned at Creighton, including the final 32
 - 32 credit hours of business coursework earned at Creighton
 - Achieve overall cumulative GPA of 2.00 or above
- ⁴ Students must earn a minimum of 48 credit hours in courses numbered 300 or above (herein 300+). The combination of the Heider Business Core – Upper Division and Heider Major guarantees a minimum of 39-42 credit hours in 300+ coursework, depending on whether the Global & Cross-Cultural Business requirement is applied (i.e., double counted) toward the Heider Major. Most Kingfisher Concentrations also include some 300+ coursework. Students will, therefore, need as few as 0 and as many as 9 credit hours of 300+ coursework beyond the Heider Business Core – Upper Division, Heider Major, and Kingfisher Concentration.
