*Neurology Outpatient: PGY2, PGY3, and PGY4 residents have one half-day Neurology Continuity Clinic (10%) and one half-day Neurology Sub-Specialty Clinic (10%) each week. Together, these clinics account for the 20% outpatient designation mentioned above. However, PGY2 and PGY4 residents do not have the Sub-Specialty Clinic during the first three months of the academic year, and PGY3 residents do not have the Sub-specialty Clinic during the first month the academic year, resulting in only a 10% outpatient designation during that period.
