

Creighton University uses a curriculum developed in accord with local and national Community Health Worker (CHW) Core Competencies

CHWs receive over 150 hours of training

- Over 100 hours of didactic instruction, small group learning, case studies, and more.
- Over 30 hours of self-guided study and work
- 80 CHWs are trained and certified at the end of each cohort
- Monthly stiped for all trainees who participate in the program

Of the 80 certified CHWs, 15 work with state-wide partners as full-time apprentices, certified with the Department of Labor.

- Apprentices receive an additional 2,000 hours of on-the-job training and mentoring.
- Apprentices are guaranteed at least a \$16/hour wage to start, with an increase after 6 months.
