Student Parking Information for 2023-2024

Dear Omaha Campus Students,

You can begin purchasing your permit for the 2023-2024 academic year in June through <u>JayPark</u>. Garage spaces will be allocated via a lottery process; decals will be mailed directly to your home, not to the University; and enforcement will begin on Aug. 1, 2023.

To receive your decal prior to Aug. 1, please order your permit by July 21. The peel-and-stick decals should be displayed on the inside of your windshield on the passenger side. If you change vehicles for any reason, temporarily or permanently, the decal can be transferred to the other vehicle.

Students who will study abroad during the spring semester or graduate in December can now purchase a fall-only surface decal at a discounted price. Those studying abroad this fall should wait to purchase a permit in December at a prorated price.

Dental and health sciences students (all School of Medicine, School of Pharmacy and Health Professions and commuter/nonresidential College of Nursing students), you will be receiving a separate e-mail with parking information specific for you.

All students will receive updates closer to the registration time with more details about parking options, along with links to updated campus parking maps on the parking website. Please review the information below and send any questions to parking@creighton.edu.

Can you tell me more about garage parking?

The University has 751 stalls inside covered parking garages – with 100% of the 24th Street garage and 85% of the 20th Steet garage allocated to students, and priority given to residential students. The 67 garage parking stalls under Kenefick and Heider halls are assigned to residents of those buildings.

Please note:

- New this year, to maximize garage usage, vehicles with garage decals will not be authorized to park in surface lots during the business day.
- The tops of parking garages are reserved for employee parking during the business day.
- From 4 p.m. to 6 a.m. on weeknights and all through the weekend, vehicles with garage decals may park in any student or employee lot.

How do students apply for a garage permit?

- If you want to park inside a garage, add yourself to the waitlist on the garage(s) of your choice through JayPark. Waitlist registration opens June 5 and closes at midnight on June 16.
- All garage parking will be offered to students through a random lottery on June 19.
- You may register for more than one garage and prioritize your preferences. Only register for garages you are willing to accept. (Example: students living in Opus, Davis, and Kenefick halls generally don't want to park in the 24th Street garage.)
- Students selected in the lottery will receive an email on June 19 with an offer for a specific garage.
 You must accept the offer and authorize the charge to your student account by midnight on June
 23. If you do not respond, the system will rescind the offer and move to the next student on the waitlist.
- If you would prefer to park in a surface lot closer to your academic buildings, don't buy a garage decal, which will only be valid in the awarded garage. Vehicles with garage permits parked in surface lots during the business day will be cited.

What are the important dates to remember?

- June 5-16: Register for the garage lottery
- June 19: Lottery is held; garage offers sent to your Creighton e-mail
- June 23: Accept and pay for garage decal by this date or lose the offer
- June 26: All other permit purchasing begins
- Aug. 1: Enforcement begins; permits or decals must be displayed to park on campus property
