**TRANSITIONS OF CARE POLICY  
(TO ACCOMPANY CREIGHTON UNIVERSITY TRANSITIONS OF CARE)  
2022-2023**

**Purpose**

The purpose of the Transitions of Care (TOC) policy is to ensure that there is a continuum of care for all patients on the podiatric service.

**Policy**

1. Check-out rounds will occur either at 1800 on Sunday or 0600 on Monday.
2. The resident coming off call and on-coming call resident need to attend as well as supervision by an attending (either PD or APD).
3. Every patient on the podiatric service must be included.
4. Both verbal and written communication (via EPIC) must occur.
5. Updated virtual patient lists are reviewed and discussed to the oncoming team.
6. No paper list is to be used during the TOC process.
7. Patient status, possible changes and the care plan will be addressed and documented.
8. The outgoing call resident will be in charge of the transition of care and is responsible for having a thorough plan in their last inpatient note to detail the TOC process.
9. TOC from attending to attending will be conducted according to the call schedule found on the Vine through WebEx.
