One-month rotations may include: OB/GYN, Anesthesia, Neurosurgery and Radiology; provided complement is sufficient to support. Electives also allowed for PGY3 residents based on fellowship aspiration.

Gen Surg = GENERAL SURGERY	No fewer than 48-weeks of full-time clinical activity in each residency year , regardless of the amount of operative experience obtained. The remaining four weeks of the year are considered non-clinical time that may be used for any purpose. Residents may take documented family leave; whereby ABS will accept 140-weeks of training in the first three years of residency and 92-weeks in the last two years of residency.

PTO does not accrue from year to year, and the unused portion cannot be taken as a lump sum at the end of a resident year as a 'cash-out'.
